- 6. My gracious Master and my God, assist me to proclaim, to spread through all the earth abroad the honours of your name.








26-5-1921 ------17-7-2008



The first church at **Dundas opened on 7th** January 1825. The Wesleyan Chapel and schoolhouse were built on the ridge overlooking Dundas Valley. No photo has been found.



A new church was built and officially opened on 10th October 1866.





- 2. Crown him, ye martyrs of our God, who from his altar call; praise him whose way of pain you trod, and crown him Lord of all.




- 3. Ye heirs of Israel's chosen race, ye ransomed from the fall, hail him who saves you by his grace, and crown him Lord of all.
- 4. Sinners, whose love can ne'er forget the wormwood and the gall, go spread your trophies at his feet and crown him Lord of all.




5. Let every tribe and every tongue responsive to his call, now shout in universal song and crown him Lord of all.


For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried.
On the third day he rose again


On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.

PRAYERS OF THE PEOPLE





4. Days of darkness still may meet me, sorrow's paths I oft may tread; but his presence still is with me, by his guiding hand I'm led.




5. He will keep me till the river rolls its waters at my feet: then he'll bear me safely over, where the loved ones I shall meet.
