and crown him Lord of all.

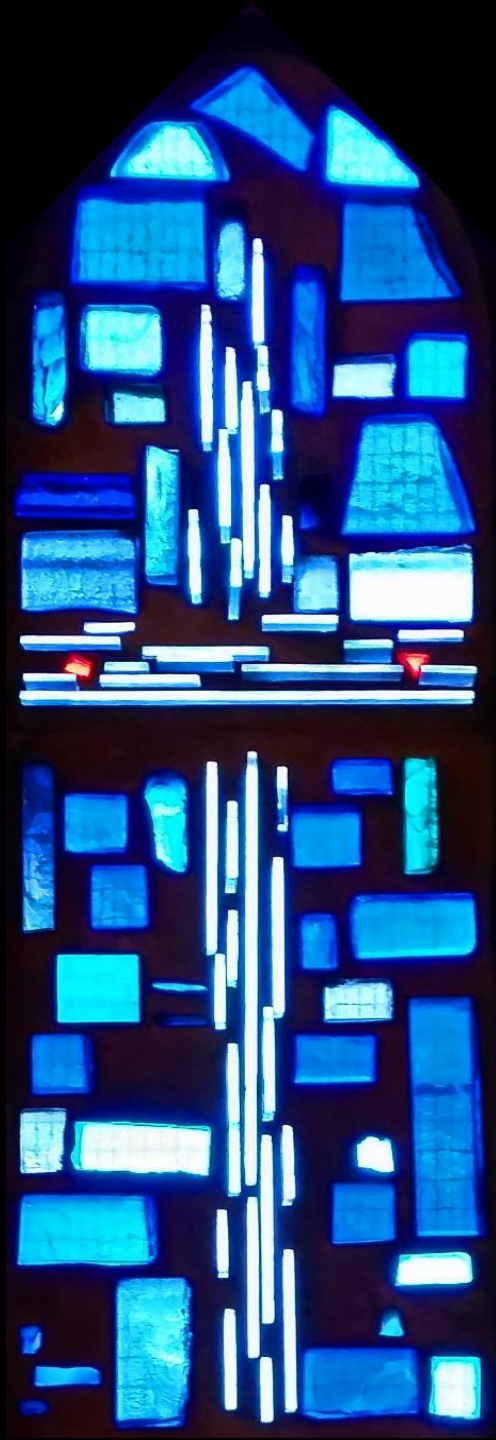
4. Sinners, whose love can ne'er forget

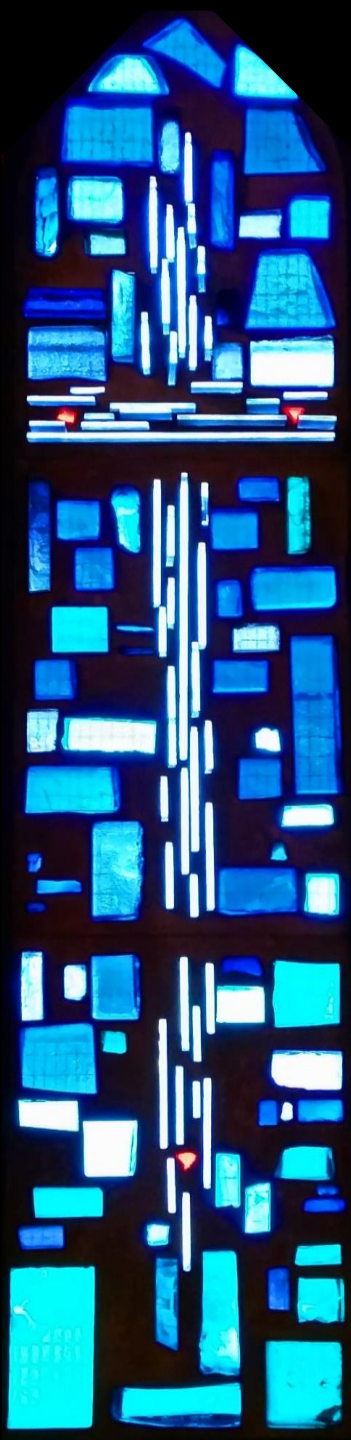

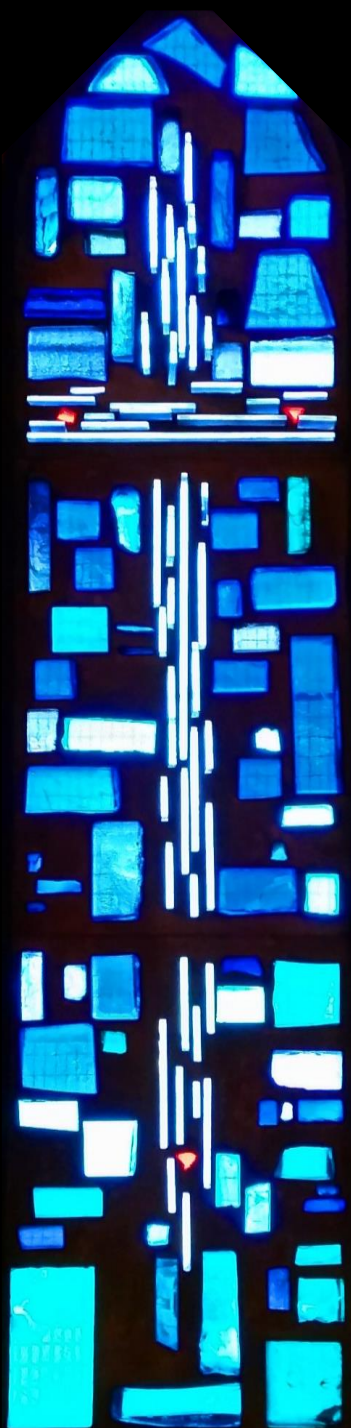

of all that is, seen and unseen.*

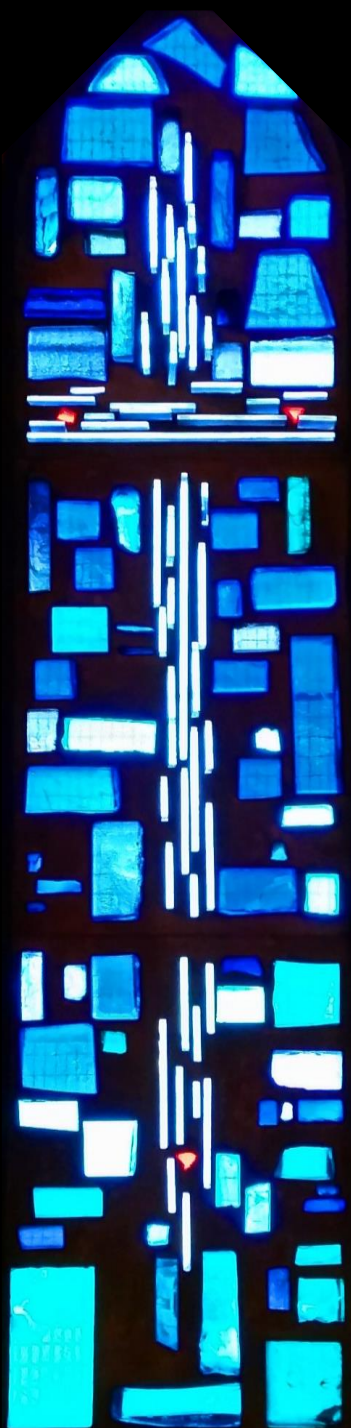

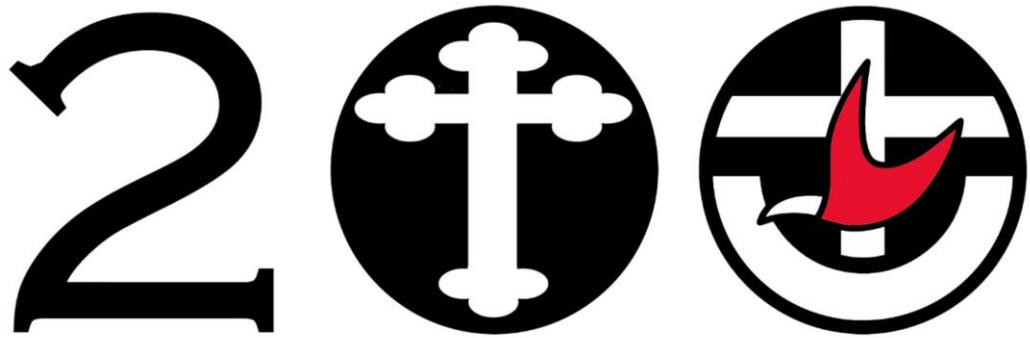
***We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the

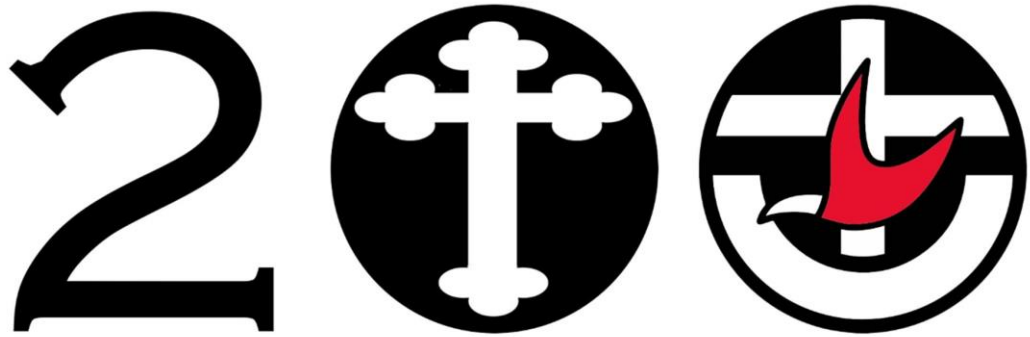
